

Rental Rules and Regulations

- It is understood that the person-in-charge and/or the organization will be responsible for the actions and safety of the group and will comply with rules as stated, including the responsible and legal consumption of alcohol when permitted.
- The person-in-charge and/or the organization is responsible for obtaining a copy of any vendor/caterer permits or licenses, this includes the Baltimore County Food Service Facility Permit and One-Day Alcoholic Beverage License when applicable along with the required liability insurance paperwork. Permits must be sent to the park office no later than 10 days before the scheduled meeting/program.
- Drinking or possessing alcoholic beverages outside designated areas or on parking lots is strictly prohibited. Rentals need pre-approval for alcohol (beer and wine only). Pre-approval is not guaranteed.
- Charcoal-type fires are permitted only in private or park owned grills. No open fires of any type are permitted without approval and written consent of the Chief of Baltimore County Fire Department. No fires of any type are permitted inside the pavilion or the Bannaky House.
- We are a trash-free park. Groups or individuals using the park are expected to take all trash with them. Clean up of debris and restoring the area as much as possible to a clean condition is the responsibility of the renting party.
- Set-up and arrangement of tables is the responsibility of the renting party. Only the tables on-hand in the immediate area are available for use. The Compass Pavilion accommodates 3-4 tables and 25-30 people. Only small canopy tents (not exceeding 12' x 12') are allowed with prior approval, but should not use any in-ground stakes.
- Parking is not permitted in the roads of the park, including the access road near the Compass Pavilion.
- If the permitted group does not vacate the premises by the end of the designated rental time, they may incur additional charges at the park's discretion.
- The park closing time is sunset or 8 pm, whichever occurs first, unless otherwise noted on the rental permit.
- Mini-bikes, go-carts, etc. are prohibited. Motorized vehicles are not allowed off the paved areas and should not be driven on the grass.
- Pets must be leashed and owners responsible for clean-up. Horses are not allowed on park grounds unless approved by park management.
- Moon-bounces and/or other inflatables are not permitted on any county property.
- Horse-shoe playing is only allowed in designated areas.
- If you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, please contact us as soon as possible as someone else may be able to utilize the date requested. Refunds will not be granted under any circumstance.
- The park attendant is the final authority in any dispute regarding the interpretation of printed park rules and regulations or in any other matter that may arise that is not covered by the park rules and regulations.
- Sound producing equipment must be kept to an individual hearing level to avoid disturbing others.
- Person-in-charge and/or organization will adhere to maximum number of guests stated on your rental contract. 30 people is always the maximum.
- Any violation of the rules and regulations shall result in revocation of the park permit, and the group will be required to vacate the park. The group may also be subject to legal action.
